- Emergency Pass holders issued by the sheriff department
- Employees know to return to work after getting families secured
- Tailgates annually for fire and earthquake
- Portable generators and a trailer mounted generator
- Use Hoses and sprinklers for rooftops
- Evacuate vehicles to big green and the sand bed to keep them safe
- Purchase of cots and sleeping bags for staff that will need somewhere to stay

Rick and myself attended a FEMA class given by the LA County fire chief which he explained that all plans whether they are fire or earthquake need to be adaptable at all times. No plan exists that covers everything. Employees and management must work together to adapt to each situation that arises to help overcome the problems at hand and come together to resolve any and all issues as quickly as possible for the betterment of the District.
