4. The undersigned will execute the Contract Agreement and furnish the required proof of insurance coverage within ten (10) days (not including Sundays and holidays) after Notice of Award to him/her of acceptance of his/her Bid by the Owner.

The undersigned Bidder further agrees that if he/she shall fail to complete the Work within the Contract Time and any authorized extension thereof, he/she shall pay liquidated damages to the Owner for each calendar day of unauthorized delay in completion of the Work, until the Work is completed, unless another amount is agreed to and stated in the Contract Agreement.
